A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE
AIEA AND PEARL CITY AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$253,809,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2005-2006, for the
4 following capital improvements in the eleventh senatorial
5 district:

6 1. Aiea elementary school

7 A. Design and construction of a covered walkway
8 connecting building C with covered access to
9 the rest of the school.

16 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized in this Act, shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
19 made; provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as
20 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

21 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the capital
22 improvement projects set forth in section 1, items 1 to 15 shall

1 be expended by the department of education for the purposes of
 2 this Act. Section 1, item 16 shall be expended by the
 3 University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. Section 1,
 4 item 17 shall be expended by the department of accounting and
 5 general services.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
