# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public school  
2 students attending Oahu schools have greatly benefited from the  
3 Hoa Aina O Makaha cultural learning center, where students  
4 participate in a variety of educational, cultural, and after-  
5 school programs. The center serves as a classroom without walls  
6 and standards-based instruction has been provided by a  
7 department of education resource teacher to over four thousand  
8 students who have visited from the Leeward coast and throughout  
9 Oahu during the past school year. Five thousand students are  
10 scheduled to visit the cultural learning center and be provided  
11 with standards-based activities and lessons connected to the  
12 Hawaii content and performance standards in school year 2005-  
13 2006.

14           The purpose of this Act is to provide funds to continue a  
15 teacher position at the Hoa Aina O Makaha cultural learning  
16 center so that the organization can continue to provide  
17 standards-connected programs and activities to public school  
18 students.

1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so  
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for  
 4 the purpose of funding a teacher position at Hoa Aina O Makaha  
 5 cultural learning center.

6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the  
 7 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
