# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2005.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is  
2 amended adding a new section to part III to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 4.1 Provided that of the special fund  
4 appropriation to the Hawaii tourism authority (BED113), the sum  
5 of \$1,327,887 shall be transferred to the economic planning and  
6 research program of the department of business, economic  
7 development, and tourism (BED130), which transfer shall not  
8 constitute an expenditure from the tourism special fund."

9 SECTION 2. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is  
10 amended by amending section 3, item K.6. to read as follows:
