# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2005.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 4.1 Provided that of the special fund  
4 appropriation to the Hawaii tourism authority (BED 113), the sum  
5 of \$1,327,887 shall be transferred to the economic planning and  
6 research program of the department of business, economic  
7 development, and tourism (BED 130)."

8 SECTION 2. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is  
9 amended by amending part II, section 3, item A.6. to read as  
10 follows:

11 "BED113 - TOURISM  
12 OPERATING BED 25,000A A  
13 3.00\* 3.00\*  
14 BED 117,200,000B [~~117,200,000B~~]  
15 120,027,887B"

16 SECTION 3. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is  
17 amended by amending section 3, item K.6. to read as follows:
