# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$41,273,000, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
5 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
6 the eighteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kamaile Elementary School

8       A. Installation of air

9           conditioning in 9 portable

10          classrooms, computer lab,

11          and media room                                 \$75,000

12       B. Removal of Mimosa trees

16 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 17 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 19 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
 20 of June 30, 2008 shall lapse as of that date.

21 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 22 capital projects set forth in subsections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7,




1 8, and 9 of section 1 of this Act shall be expended by the  
2 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective  
4 capital projects set forth in subsection 10 of section 1 of this  
5 Act shall be expended by the department of land and natural  
6 resources for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective  
8 capital projects set forth in subsections 11 and 12 of section 1  
9 of this Act shall be expended by the department of Hawaiian  
10 homelands for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective  
12 capital projects set forth in subsection 13 of section 1 of this  
13 Act shall be expended by the department of health for the  
14 purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
