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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$145,499,000, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year  
5 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for  
6 the first senatorial district, as follows:

7 1.    Waiakea Kai Ramp

8           Two-lane boat launch ramp, to be  
9           located within Waialoa small boat  
10          harbor - Suisan Basin along west makai  
11          dock with boat wash down area, parking  
12          for trucks and boat trailers

5 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
6 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
7 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
8 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
9 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
11 capital projects set forth in:

12 (1) Items 1 and 2 shall be expended by the department of  
13 land and natural resources;

14 (2) Items 3-14 shall be expended by the department of  
15 education; and

16 (3) Item 15 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii  
17 at Hilo

18 for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
