
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The employer-union health benefits trust fund
2 shall study the cost and other impacts of providing health
3 insurance to persons hired by the State as emergency and
4 temporary hires and part-time employees who work less than
5 twenty hours a week who would otherwise not have health
6 insurance coverage.

7 The report shall include but not be limited to:

8 (1) An estimate of the total number of persons hired by
9 the State as emergency and temporary hires and part-
10 time employees who work less than twenty hours a week
11 who would otherwise not have health insurance
12 coverage;

13 (2) An estimate of the number of persons hired by the
14 State as emergency and temporary hires and part-time
15 employees who work less than twenty hours a week who
16 would otherwise not have health insurance coverage
17 that would be eligible for health insurance coverage



1 if the employer-union health benefits trust fund
2 provided it; and

3 (3) The estimated costs of providing health insurance
4 coverage to these hires and employees, including
5 estimates broken down on a shared cost basis.

6 SECTION 2. The employer-union health benefits trust fund
7 shall submit the report required under section 1 of this Act and
8 any proposed legislation to the legislature not later than
9 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
10 2007.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
