
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$345,785,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the nineteenth senatorial district, as follows:

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
16 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
19 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
21 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the



1 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;

2 provided that:

3 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 9 shall be
4 expended by the department of education; and

5 (2) The sums appropriated in items 10 through 12 shall be
6 expended by the department of transportation; and

7 (3) The sums appropriated in item 13 shall be expended by
8 the University of Hawaii.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
