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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE TENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ , or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the  
4 following capital improvements in the tenth senatorial district:

5 1. Ala Wai elementary school, Oahu

6 A. Renovate bathrooms in classroom

7 buildings A, B, and C. \$ 300,000

8 B. Renovate bathrooms in office. 100,000

9 C. Replace school perimeter fence. 60,000

10 Project total \$ 460,000

11 2. Hokulani elementary school, Oahu

12 A. Installation of permanent fencing,

13 cattle gate, lighting and asphalt

14 Koali parking area.

15 Design \$ 50,000

16 Construction 215,000

 22 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is




1 made; provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as  
2 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the capital  
4 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by  
5 the department of education for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
