5 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
 6 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 7 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
 8 provided that:

- 9 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 to 3 and 5 to 10
 10 shall be expended by the department of education; and
- 11 (2) The sum appropriated in item 4 shall be expended by
 12 the department of land and natural resources.

13 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
 14 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 15 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
