S.B. NO. 3100

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2006-2007, for the following capital improvements in the
6 fifteenth senatorial district:

7 1. Salt Lake Waterway

8 Appropriate funds for Salt Lake

9 Waterway clean-up, phase III. \$1,000,000

10 2. Aliamanu Elementary School

11 A. Installation of acoustical tile
