A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARK ACQUISITIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to purchase Waiehu beach park which consists of 1.6 acres of
3 beachfront property located on the island of Maui. The park has
4 been used for many years by beach goers and was recently offered
5 to the county by its owners, Wailuku Agribusiness, for \$750,000.

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$750,000, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
9 department of land and natural resources to purchase the
10 1.6-acre Waiehu beach park from Wailuku Agribusiness located on
11 the island of Maui, and shall not be used for any other purpose.

12 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
13 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
14 this Act.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
