
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE COMMUNITY WORK DAY PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The litter control office, established by
2 chapter 339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, existed from 1977 until
3 1996, when it was administratively closed to budgetary
4 constraints. The legislature finds that the office provided a
5 critical, necessary, and strategic service to the public in
6 serving as the focal point to plan, coordinate, and implement
7 litter control efforts.

8 The litter control office was very successful in its
9 efforts to clean up, prevent, and educate the public about
10 litter. Among its accomplishments were: an annual statewide
11 recycling campaign, including a fundraising program for
12 businesses; an annual statewide litter campaign; involvement of
13 volunteers from organizations; a training program for
14 volunteers; resolution complaints of littered sites, including
15 abandoned vehicles; fundraising from organizations and
16 individuals; establishment of partnerships with civic and
17 community groups, school and other youth organizations and



1 businesses; community work day program; and a shoreline and
2 coastal cleanup.

3 The community work day program is part of the national keep
4 America beautiful program, which partners with businesses and
5 uses in-kind donations to create successful education and
6 action-oriented programs for island-wide cleanups, roadside
7 beautification programs, and cleanup of polluted water bodies,
8 among other clean environment efforts.

9 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation from
10 the tourism special fund for the community work day program.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated the sum of \$,
12 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
13 2006-2007, for the community work day program, to be
14 appropriated twenty-five per cent from the Hawaii Tourism
15 Authority's community product enrichment program fund, and
16 seventy-five per cent from the deposit beverage container
17 deposit special fund pursuant to section 342G-104(b)(2), Hawaii
18 Revised Statutes.

19 The sum appropriated shall be distributed to each county as
20 follows:

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
5 tourism authority and the department of health for the purposes
6 of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
