
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§304- Hawaii scholars program. (a) There is
5 established the Hawaii scholars program to be administered by
6 the University of Hawaii. This program shall be used to provide
7 financial assistance for up to five academic years to any
8 qualified student enrolled at any campus of the University of
9 Hawaii.

10 (b) Appropriations for this program in each fiscal year
11 shall be an amount not more than the number of eligible students
12 for the program during the prior fiscal year multiplied by the
13 average tuition cost and fees charged per student by the
14 University of Hawaii in the previous fiscal year.

15 (c) The University of Hawaii shall offer full
16 scholarships, covering the cost of tuition and fees, the cost of
17 books, and the costs of on-campus housing, under this program to



1 any Hawaii resident applying to any campus within the University
2 of Hawaii system; provided that the individual:

3 (1) Graduated from a public or private high school in the
4 State as valedictorian;

5 (2) Enrolls at a campus within the University of Hawaii
6 system within eighteen months of graduating from that
7 high school; and

8 (3) Maintains a level of academic excellence, as
9 determined by the board of regents, while on
10 scholarship.

11 (d) Any appropriation left unexpended as of the close of
12 the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made shall be
13 credited against the appropriation in the following fiscal
14 year."

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
18 deposit into the student scholarship and assistance special
19 fund.

20 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
21 University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

22 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
