# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE TWENTY-THIRD SENATORIAL  
DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$                   , or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2006-2007, for  
4 plans, designs, construction, and equipment for the following



10     SECTION 2. The appropriations made for capital improvement  
 11 projects authorized in this Act shall not lapse at the end of  
 12 the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made;  
 13 provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as of  
 14 June 30, 2009, shall lapse as of that date.

15     SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the  
 16 department of education.

17     SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
