# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHAPTER 281, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 281-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§281-35 Special conditions, club licenses.** No liquor  
4 shall be sold under a club license to any person not a member of  
5 the club nor a guest thereof enjoying the privilege of  
6 membership, but a member or a guest enjoying the privileges of  
7 membership may purchase liquor for consumption on the premises  
8 by the person's own guests. [~~No guest of a member or of a guest  
9 enjoying the privileges of membership shall purchase or be  
10 permitted to purchase liquor on the premises.]~~

11           The liquor commission may by regulations require the  
12 keeping and posting of lists of the members of a club, and the  
13 keeping and production of records as to membership and the  
14 registration of guests enjoying the privileges of membership.

15           No liquor shall be sold or kept for sale at any club except  
16 by the club itself pursuant to its license. If any liquor is  
17 sold or kept on the club premises for sale or barter by any  
18 member, employee, or person other than the club itself, the club



1 shall be deemed to be selling without a license whether it holds  
2 its own license or not."

3 SECTION 2. Section 281-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

5 "(c) A county may increase the requirements for transfers  
6 of class 5, category [~~+2~~] (B) and [~~+4~~], (D), and class 11  
7 licenses by ordinance designating one or more areas within the  
8 county as special liquor districts and specifying the  
9 requirements applicable to transfers of any of these licenses  
10 within each district."

11 SECTION 3. Section 281-94, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "**§281-94 Forfeiture of fee paid.** If any license is  
14 revoked [~~and~~] or canceled by the liquor commission or liquor  
15 control adjudication board, the fee paid for the license shall  
16 be forfeited to the county as respects the unexpired portion of  
17 the fee paid for the license."

18 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
