A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A GRANT TO THE OPEN DOOR ACADEMY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Open Door Academy is an entity that intends
2 to operate a faith-based rehabilitation and technical training
3 center. The Academy:

4 (1) Gives homeless and at-risk youth emergency shelter;

5 (2) Provides a training center for former inmates;

6 (3) Creates a viable option for low-risk youth offenders;

7 (4) Reduces the number of inmates sent out of state;

8 (5) Provides food, emergency shelter, and counseling to
9 those in need;

10 (6) Tests those in need to determine their natural
11 abilities;

12 (7) Provides job training and job placement services; and

13 (8) Provides transition to affordable housing or home
14 ownership.

15 The purpose of this Act is to make a grant to The Open Door
16 Academy to provide temporary shelter, education, and job
17 training and placement to homeless and at-risk youth.

1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
 4 a grant to The Open Door Academy to provide temporary shelter,
 5 education, and job training and placement to homeless or at-risk
 6 youth.

7 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
 8 department of human services for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
