
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HISTORIC PRESERVATION SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§6E-16 Hawaii historic preservation special fund. (a)**

4 There is established a Hawaii historic preservation special fund
5 into which shall be deposited the following moneys:

6 (1) Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund;

7 (2) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and
8 private persons; [~~and~~]

9 (3) All proceeds collected by the department derived from
10 historic preserve user fees, historic preserve leases
11 or concession fees, fees charged to carry out the
12 purposes of this chapter, or the sale of goods[~~-~~]; and

13 (4) Civil, criminal, and administrative penalties, fines,
14 and other charges collected under this chapter or any
15 rule adopted pursuant to this chapter.

16 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in the fund
17 shall become part of the fund. The fund shall be administered
18 by the department; provided that the department may contract



1 with a public or private agency to provide the day-to-day
2 management of the fund.

3 (b) ~~[The]~~ Subject to legislative authorization, the
4 department may expend moneys from the fund ~~[to]~~:

5 (1) For permanent and temporary staff positions;

6 (2) To replenish goods ~~[, to]~~;

7 (3) To produce public information materials ~~[, and to]~~;

8 (4) To provide financial assistance to public agencies and
9 private agencies in accordance with chapter ~~[42D]~~ 42F
10 involved in historic preservation activities other
11 than those covered by section 6E-9 ~~[,]~~ and

12 (5) To cover administrative and operational costs of the
13 historic preservation program.

14 (c) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with
15 chapter 91 for the purposes of this section."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Hawaii Historic Preservation Special Fund

Description:

Clarifies that civil, criminal, and administrative penalties, fines, and other charges collected under Chapter 6E, HRS, shall be deposited in the Hawaii Historic Preservation Special Fund. Allows Special Fund moneys, subject to legislative authorization, to be used to pay for staff positions and administrative and operational costs. (CD1)
