
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO
PROHIBIT ALL COMMERCIAL VENDORS AT THE NU'UANU PALI LOOKOUT
ON THE ISLAND OF OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, the Nu'uaniu Pali lookout in Nu'uaniu valley on the
2 island of Oahu has one of the most spectacular views in Hawaii;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, the 985-foot cliff side of the Ko'olau mountain
6 range offers one of the best panoramic views of the windward
7 coast; and

9 WHEREAS, it was on this cliff side in 1795 that King
10 Kamehameha fought one of the bloodiest battles in Hawaiian
11 history when he conquered the island of Oahu and united the
12 Hawaiian islands under his rule; and

14 WHEREAS, recently, there have been commercial vendors
15 selling food, trinkets, and other items at the Nu'uaniu Pali
16 Lookout; and

18 WHEREAS, for many, using the Nu'uaniu Pali Lookout, a place
19 of such historical significance, to sell items by commercial
20 vendors is disrespectful and degrades the dignity that this area
21 deserves; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third
24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006, the
25 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land
26 and Natural Resources eliminate all commercial vendors from the
27 Nu'uaniu Pali Lookout; and
