
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TO PRESENT A HOMELAND
SECURITY PLAN TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1 WHEREAS, the scourge of terrorism continues to threaten our
2 world, our nation, and our state; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the federal government, through the Office for
5 Domestic Preparedness (ODP) and State Homeland Security Program
6 (SHSP), has made \$45,000,000 in funding available to help
7 protect our state and its people; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the state Department of Defense (DOD) seeks to
10 expend the \$45,000,000 for homeland security in Hawaii; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature is also deeply concerned about the
13 protection of Hawaii's residents and visitors; now, therefore,
14

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third
16 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006, the
17 House of Representatives concurring, that DOD is requested to
18 submit to the Legislature for approval a homeland security plan
19 (Plan) for the expenditure of the \$45,000,000 from ODP and SHSP;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Plan must include:

- 24 (1) An assessment of the threat of terrorist incidents;

 - 26 (2) The development of plans to deal with terrorist

 - 29 (3) Training and exercises to implement such plans; and

 - 31 (4) The procurement of equipment, materials, and supplies
32 essential to meet the potential threats of

1 conventional, chemical, biological, radiological, and
2 nuclear weapons;

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan be presented to the
6 Legislature for approval as expeditiously as possible; and

7
8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan include ways to help
9 the counties increase their security efforts; and

10
11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as far as practicable, the DOD
12 collaborate with the counties in developing the Plan and
13 determining how the moneys from ODP and SHSP can be expended
14 most effectively; and

15
16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Adjutant
18 General; mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, County of
19 Hawaii, County of Maui, and County of Kauai; and the county
20 councils of Honolulu, Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai.
