# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PRESENT A HOMELAND  
SECURITY PLAN TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1           WHEREAS, the scourge of terrorism continues to threaten our  
2 world, our nation, and our State; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, the federal government has made \$80,000,000 in  
5 funding available through the Office for Domestic Preparedness  
6 and the state Homeland Security Program to help protect our  
7 State and its people; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, the state Department of Defense seeks to expend  
10 the \$80,000,000 for homeland security in Hawaii; and

11  
12           WHEREAS, the Legislature is also deeply concerned about the  
13 protection of Hawaii's residents and visitors; now, therefore,

14  
15           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
16 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
17 of 2006, the House of Representatives concurring, that  
18 Department of Defense is requested to submit to the Legislature  
19 for approval a Homeland Security Plan for the expenditure of the  
20 \$85,000,000 from the Office for Domestic Preparedness and the  
21 state Homeland Security Program; and

23           BE IT RESOLVED that the Homeland Security Plan shall  
24 include:

26           (1) An assessment of the threat of terrorist incidents;  
27  
28           (2) The development of plans to deal with terrorist  
29 incidents;

31           (3) Training and exercises to implement such plans;

- 1 (4) The procurement of equipment, materials, and supplies
- 2 essential to meet the potential threats of
- 3 conventional, chemical, biological, radiological, and
- 4 nuclear weapons;

- 6 (5) The identification of any necessary procurement or
- 7 taking of infrastructure for essential operational,
- 8 storage, or administrative purposes;
- 9
- 10 (6) The ability to increase effective communications
- 11 capability with local government agencies and the
- 12 public regarding incidents and threats; and

- 14 (7) The ability to increase the deployment of law
- 15 enforcement and first responder personnel, and the
- 16 capabilities to detect, prevent, protect against,
- 17 respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks;

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Homeland Security Plan be  
21 presented to the Legislature for approval as expeditiously as  
22 possible; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Homeland Security Plan  
25 include ways to help the counties increase their security  
26 efforts; and

27  
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as much as practicable, the  
29 Department of Defense shall collaborate with the counties to  
30 develop the Homeland Security Plan and to determine how the  
31 moneys from the Office for Domestic Preparedness and the State  
32 Homeland Security Program can be expended most effectively; and

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
35 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Adjutant  
36 General; mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, County of  
37 Hawaii, County of Maui, and County of Kauai; and the County  
38 Councils of Honolulu, Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai.
