# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HONOLULU BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO WORK WITH THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF HAWAII ON THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WAIHAOLE VALLEY WATER SYSTEM AND FOR THE BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF THE UPGRADED WATER SYSTEM.

1 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Corporation  
2 of Hawaii is the current fee simple owner of the Waiahole Valley  
3 Agricultural Park and Residential Lots Subdivision; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, the Waiahole Valley Water System currently serves  
6 one hundred sixty-seven residential and agricultural lessees,  
7 twenty-two kuleana lots, and twenty Department of Hawaiian Home  
8 Lands lots, as well as the Waiahole Elementary School; and

10 WHEREAS, the Waiahole Valley Water System is underdesigned  
11 and was not fully completed causing system deficiencies, high  
12 operation and maintenance costs, frequent water main breaks,  
13 significant damage to properties, time delays in responding to,  
14 and repairing main breaks, and lower levels of service  
15 reliability; and

17 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Corporation  
18 of Hawaii's primary function is to provide affordable housing,  
19 not water system management; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, the Board of Water Supply will be responsible for  
22 domestic water delivery; and  
23

24 WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed regarding the  
25 reliability of domestic water delivery; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, the quality of domestic water to the residents of  
28 Waiahole Valley is of utmost importance to their health and
