## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURES FOR PLACING A CHILD IN TEMPORARY FOSTER CUSTODY WITH KIN OR NON-KIN FOSTER PARENTS.

1           WHEREAS, foster custody places a very emotional and  
2 sometimes traumatic burden on children in the foster care  
3 system; and

4  
5           WHEREAS, when a child is placed in a foster home, foster  
6 parents generally form a bond with the foster child, yet many  
7 foster children long to seek out their kin; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, foster care is a very complex issue because many  
10 emotions for everyone are involved, and each situation is  
11 different, making the decision to place a child in a home a  
12 difficult one for social workers; and

13  
14           WHEREAS, the best interests of a child should be paramount  
15 in determining the placement of a child in foster custody; and

16  
17           WHEREAS, the House of Representatives' Committee on Human  
18 Services held a public hearing to discuss H.B. No. 1856,  
19 regarding the issue of placing a child with kin or non-kin  
20 foster caregivers; and

21  
22           WHEREAS, compelling testimony was received with many  
23 viewpoints, all of which were valid and worthy of further  
24 discussion; and

25  
26           WHEREAS, because many issues remain unresolved and  
27 difficult to determine because of the complexities and unique



1 circumstances of each child's situation, more discussions with  
2 various stakeholders need to take place; now, therefore,

3  
4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third  
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006, the  
6 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of  
7 Human Services (DHS) is requested to convene a working group to  
8 determine the feasibility of implementing procedures for placing  
9 a child in temporary foster custody with kin or non-kin foster  
10 parents, including the possibility of a committee to make  
11 decisions on a case-by-case basis; and

12  
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
14 to discuss, among other things:

- 15  
16 (1) Defining "attachment" as it pertains to the  
17 relationship between a foster child and a caregiver,  
18 and how attachment can be considered when determining  
19 placement of a child;  
20  
21 (2) Determining circumstances under which siblings may be  
22 separated, and finding solutions to keep siblings  
23 together whenever possible;  
24  
25 (3) Determining the length of time children should remain  
26 in the foster care system and finding solutions to  
27 minimize their time in the system, without  
28 jeopardizing the children's health or welfare; and  
29  
30 (4) Determining whether changes are needed to improve the  
31 present model of foster placement, or whether the  
32 methods of foster placement require further review and  
33 analysis;

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHS is requested to include in  
38 the working group, stakeholders, including but not limited to:

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHS is requested to submit a  
20 report to the Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the  
21 convening of the Regular Session of 2007; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
24 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human  
25 Services, Executive Director of the Hawaii Foster Parent  
26 Association, President of the Hawaii Foster Youth Coalition, and  
27 Executive Director of Hawaii Youth Services Network.
