
SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAKE EXPEDITION
OF THE COMPLETION OF THE PAIA BYPASS PROJECT A TOP
PRIORITY.

1 WHEREAS, commuter vehicles sometimes speed on a residential
2 streets in Spreckelsville, Maui, during afternoon rush hour to
3 avoid back-to-back traffic on nearby Hana Highway; and
4

5 WHEREAS, residents traveling along Hana Highway through
6 Paia say they have noticed a drastic change in the pace of
7 traffic over the past eight years, making what was once a ten
8 minute drive turn into a thirty minute wait in back-to-back
9 traffic congestion extending more than a mile; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the traffic congestion is increased by the
12 heightened awareness of Paia as a visitor destination and a
13 growing interest in visiting surfing areas north of the town,
14 such as Hookipa Beach Park and "Jaws" in Peahi; and
15

16 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has plans to
17 construct the Paia bypass highway in order to reduce traffic;
18 and
19

20 WHEREAS, Act 41, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, the
21 Supplemental Budget Appropriations Act of 2004, made an
22 appropriation in TRN531 item 71 for plans, design, and
23 construction for alternative traffic improvements in the
24 vicinity of Paia town; and
25

26 WHEREAS, the appropriation was deemed necessary to qualify
27 for federal aid financing and/or reimbursement; and
28

29 WHEREAS, Act 41 appropriated for fiscal year 2003-2004 the
30 sum of \$100,000 for plans and \$1,500,000 for design, and for
31 fiscal year 2004-2005 the sum of \$37,500,000 for construction;

34 WHEREAS, work on the project still has not begun; and

1 WHEREAS, the consensus of opinion is that the bypass should
2 be completed as quickly as possible because an urgent need
3 presently exists; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation had originally
6 planned for the completion of the bypass in 2017 which was moved
7 up to 2012, which is still much too long; now, therefore,
8

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third
10 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006,
11 that the Department of Transportation is requested to expedite
12 the construction of the Paia bypass project as a top priority to
13 allow through traffic to get around the bottleneck in Paia town;
14 and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
17 Transportation move up the planned completion date of the bypass
18 from 2012; and
19

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
21 Transportation periodically conduct public information briefing
22 sessions for area residents and legislators to inform them of
23 the progress of the project; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
26 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation and
27 the Mayor and Council Chairperson of the County of Maui.
