SENATE RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE RULES OF THE SENATE OF THE TWENTY-THIRD LEGISLATURE
OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL TIME TO
CONSIDER GUBERNATORIAL NOMINATIONS.

1 WHEREAS, the rules of the Senate may be amended pursuant to
2 Senate Rule 85 with one day's notice of the change by a majority
3 vote of the members of the Senate; and

4
5 WHEREAS, when the Governor submits a nomination that
6 requires the Senate to advise and consent, adequate time must be
7 provided in order to thoroughly consider the Governor's nominee
8 or nominees; and

9
10 WHEREAS, the Senate finds additional time is necessary to
11 consider gubernatorial nominations that require the Senate to
12 advise and consent to such a nomination; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third
15 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006,
16 that Senate Rule 37(2) be amended to read as follows (rule
17 language to be deleted is bracketed and stricken, new rule
18 language is underscored):

20 (2) Except for the appointment of a justice or
21 judge, a nomination or appointment made by the
22 Governor which is received by the Senate after the
23 {~~fifty-first~~} forty-first day of the session of the
24 Legislature shall be returned to the Governor without
25 action, unless a confirmation or consent is required
26 to further a public purpose which cannot be satisfied
27 by an interim appointment. Notice of this rule shall
28 be given to the Governor not later than the twentieth
29 day of the session of the Legislature.







