SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TO PRESENT A HOMELAND
SECURITY PLAN TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1 WHEREAS, the scourge of terrorism continues to threaten our
2 world, our nation, and our state; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the federal government, through the Office for
5 Domestic Preparedness (ODP) and State Homeland Security Program
6 (SHSP), has made \$45,000,000 in funding available to help
7 protect our state and its people; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the state Department of Defense (DOD) seeks to
10 expend the \$45,000,000 for homeland security in Hawaii; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature is also deeply concerned about the
13 protection of Hawaii's residents and visitors; now, therefore,
14

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-third
16 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2006,
17 that DOD is requested to submit to the Legislature for approval
18 a homeland security plan (Plan) for the expenditure of the
19 \$45,000,000 from ODP and SHSP; and

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Plan must include:

- 23 (1) An assessment of the threat of terrorist incidents;

 - 25 (2) The development of plans to deal with terrorist
26 incidents;

 - 28 (3) Training and exercises to implement such plans; and

 - 30 (4) The procurement of equipment, materials, and supplies
31 essential to meet the potential threats of
32 conventional, chemical, biological, radiological, and
33 nuclear weapons;

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan be presented to the
2 Legislature for approval as expeditiously as possible; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan include ways to help
5 the counties increase their security efforts; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as far as practicable, the DOD
8 collaborate with the counties in developing the Plan and
9 determining how the moneys from ODP and SHSP can be expended
10 most effectively; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
13 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Adjutant General;
14 mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, County of Hawaii,
15 County of Maui, and County of Kauai; and the county councils of
16 Honolulu, Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai.
