Sir:

Your Committees on Water, Land, & Ocean Resources and
Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 2633 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HIGHWAY IMPACT FEES,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to allow any county of Hawaii to
assess impact fees to help pay for state highway improvements
needed to service new developments.

The Department of Transportation, Mayor of the County of
Hawaii, and Land Use Research Foundation of Hawaii supported this
bill.

Your Committees note that under existing law, only the City
and County of Honolulu may assess impact fees for development.
However, development impacts every county of the state. This
measure allows other counties the same authority to assess impact
fees to pay for state highway improvements needed to service the
new developments.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Water, Land, & Ocean Resources and Transportation
that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord
with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2633 and recommend that it
pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
