Your Committee on Economic Development & Business Concerns,  
to which was referred H.B. No. 2805 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATE PLANNING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the sustainability  
of Hawaii by:

- (1) Extending the deadline for the Auditor to submit the  
"Hawaii 2050 Sustainability Plan" by an additional year,  
to December 2007; and
- (2) Extending the authority of the Hawaii 2050 Task Force to  
June 30, 2008.

The Office of the Auditor and the Department of Business,  
Economic Development, and Tourism testified in support of this  
measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Economic Development & Business Concerns that is  
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the  
intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2805 and recommends that it pass  
Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
