"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION,"

- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style.






A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003 established
2 the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii. Act 59
3 directed the department of land and natural resources to
4 preserve the visual, cultural, and historical aspects of the
5 land, and to develop a comprehensive management plan for the
6 wilderness area.

7 The purpose of this Act is to extend the length of time
8 allowed to acquire the lands that are designated to become part
9 of the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii.

10 SECTION 2. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, is amended
11 by amending section 4 to read as follows:

12 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2003;
13 provided that:

14 (1) This Act shall be repealed on December 31, [~~2006~~]
15 2007, if the exchange transactions to acquire the
16 lands described in section 6E-B are not consummated
17 prior to December 31, [~~2006~~] 2007; and



1 (2) In the event that this Act is repealed, any revisions
2 to land classifications that were made pursuant to
3 this Act shall revert to their original
4 classifications."

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
