Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 3194 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE COMMISSION FOR NATIONAL
AND COMMUNITY SERVICE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to make Hawaii statutes
consistent with federal law by reducing, from four years to three
years, the terms of the members of the Hawaii Commission on
National and Community Service.

The University of Hawaii and the Hawaii Commission for
National and Community Service supported this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 3194, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 3194, H.D. 1, and
be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.
