Sir:

Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred  
H.B. No. 3216 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ISLAND OF KAHO'OLAWA,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to ascertain the feasibility of  
deploying alternative energy resources to the island of  
Kaho'olawe, by directing the Auditor to submit findings and  
recommendations to the Legislature and Governor, including  
feasible alternative energy resources, cost analysis, assessment,  
an implementation strategy for the use of alternative energy  
resources to address the current and future energy needs of the  
island, and any proposed legislation.

Maui Memorial Hospital Auxiliary testified in support of this  
bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Requiring the Auditor to also identify infrastructure  
and transportation needs of Kaho'olawe relating to  
alternative energy resources in its findings to the  
Legislature and Governor; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,  
clarity, and consistency.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 3216, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 3216, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committees on Energy & Environmental Protection and Legislative Management.
