A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KUPUNA RECOGNITION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§8- Kupuna Recognition Day. The fourth Saturday of
5 July shall be known and designated as Kupuna Recognition Day, in
6 recognition of the very significant role that kupuna play in
7 Hawaii's culture, history, and traditions. This day is not and
8 shall not be construed as a state holiday."

9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
