Sir:

Your Committees on Hawaiian Affairs and Housing, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 119 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES PRESIDENT AND CONGRESS TO IMMEDIATELY RATIFY THE AMENDMENTS MADE TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT OF 1920, AS AMENDED, AS EMBODIED IN ACT 302, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2001, AND TO RECOGNIZE HAWAIIAN HOMESTEAD COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS AS SELF-GOVERNING ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITIES FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE COMMUNITIES,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to urge the United States President and Congress to:

- (1) Immediately ratify the amendments made to the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended, as embodied in Act 302, Session Laws of Hawaii 2001; and
- (2) Recognize Hawaiian Homestead Community Organizations as self-governing administrative authorities for their respective communities.




