Your Committee on Water, Land, & Ocean Resources, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 141 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO WORK WITH THE SAMUEL MILLS DAMON ESTATE TRUSTEES, MOANALUA GARDENS FOUNDATION, THE TRUST FOR PUBLIC LANDS, THE NATURE CONSERVANCY, AND OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS TO PURCHASE THE MOANALUA GARDENS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to protect and preserve for the people of Hawaii an area known as one of Hawaii's most treasured cultural and historical areas--Moanalua Gardens and Kamananui Valley. This measure urges a public-private effort to secure this area for public use and enjoyment for generations to come.

The Moanalua Gardens Foundation, Moanalua Gardens Community Association, Moanalua Valley Community Association, Inc., Windward Ahupuaa Alliance, and a member of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs supported this concurrent resolution. The Department of Land and Natural Resources opposed this measure. The Nature Conservancy of Hawaii provided comments.


Your Committee has amended this concurrent resolution by making technical, nonsubstantive changes for clarity, consistency, and style.
