Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 298 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COLLEGE OF
TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
HAWAII AT MANOA TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF MANDATED OR
INCENTIVE BASED VOLUNTARY ROOFTOP LANDSCAPING AND AGRICULTURE
IN URBAN DISTRICTS,"

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the
University of Hawaii's College of Tropical Agriculture and Human
Resources (CTAHR) to study the feasibility of mandated or
incentive-based voluntary rooftop landscaping.

CTAHR supported the intent of this measure. The Land Use
Research Foundation of Hawaii opposed this measure. The
Department of Agriculture provided comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No.
298 and recommends its adoption.
