Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 314 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF
HAWAII TO REVIEW AND REPORT ON THE LONG-TERM DEVELOPMENT OF
OBSERVATORY SITES ON THE SUMMIT OF MAUNA KEA,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to protect the
environmental and cultural aspects of Mauna Kea while maintaining
and enhancing its scientific importance by requesting the
University of Hawaii (UH) to review and report on the long-term
development of observatory sites on the summit of Mauna Kea.

UH and the UH Institute for Astronomy testified in support of
this concurrent resolution.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Specifying that the University of Hawaii Institute for
Astronomy is responsible for conducting the review and
preparing the report to the Legislature; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
