H.C.R. No. 56 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO
CONDUCT A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
PROJECTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION,"

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to improve the
efficiency of the planning and implementation of capital
improvement projects (CIPs) undertaken by the Department of
Transportation (DOT) by requesting the Auditor to conduct a
management audit of DOT's CIPs.

DOT submitted comments on this measure.


Your Committee finds that an audit of DOT's management of
CIPs has never been conducted. Conducting a management audit may
improve the efficiency of management of DOT's CIPs, and assist in
their expeditious completion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 56 and
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance.
