Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.R. No. 101 entitled:

COMMITMENT TO MAINTAINING A SYSTEMWIDE OFFICE OF THE VICE
PRESIDENT FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS AND TO FILL THE VACANT POSITION
OF THE VICE PRESIDENT FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS,"

The purpose of this resolution is to urge the President and
Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii (UH) to reaffirm
their commitment to maintaining a systemwide office of the Vice
President for Student Affairs and to fill the vacant position of
the Vice President for Student Affairs.

The Hawaii Commission for National and Community Service,
National Association of Student Personnel Administrators Hawaii,
Associated Students of UH at Manoa, UH Student Caucus, and several
concerned individuals testified in support of this measure. The
UH Professional Assembly and a concerned individual opposed this
measure. UH offered comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 101
and recommends its adoption.
