Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred  
H.R. No. 150 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONCEPT OF A PUBLIC-PRIVATE  
JOINT VENTURE TO DEVELOP A NEW ADVANCED SIMULATOR AIRLINE  
TRAINING FACILITY IN HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to support the concept of a  
public-private joint venture to develop a new advanced simulator  
airline training facility in Hawaii.

The Honolulu Community College and Global Aeronautics LLC,  
supported this measure. The Department of Transportation (DOT)  
supported the intent of this measure.

Your Committee believes that DOT raised legitimate concerns  
about the use of state land for aviation purposes in compliance  
with Federal Aviation Administration policies and procedures.  
These concerns need to be addressed prior to entering into a  
public-private joint venture.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,  
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 150  
and recommends its adoption.
