Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.R. No. 198 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII BOARD
OF REGENTS TO NAME THE KOMOHANA RESEARCH AND EXTENSION CENTER
IN HONOR OF TADASHI HIGAKI,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to request the University
of Hawaii Board of Regents to name the Komohana Research and
Extension Center in honor of Tadashi Higaki.

Green Point Nurseries, Inc., Big Island Dendrobium Growers
Association, and numerous concerned individuals supported this
measure. The University of Hawaii at Manoa's College of Tropical
Agriculture and Human Resources provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Clarifying the provision to reflect only naming the
administrative and extension wing of the Komohana
Research and Extension Center in honor of Tadashi
Higaki;
- (2) Changing the title to read: "REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY
OF HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS TO NAME THE ADMINISTRATIVE
AND EXTENSION WING OF THE KOMOHANA RESEARCH AND
EXTENSION CENTER IN HONOR OF TADASHI HIGAKI"; and



- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for consistency, clarity, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 198, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as H.R. No. 198, H.D. 1.
