Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 2004, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to establish the Ahu o Laka State Monument as a protected and maintained historical, cultural, and aesthetically valued site at Kaneohe, Oahu, to be administered by the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR).

DLNR, the Koolaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club, Keahiakahoe Canoe Club, Kahaluu Neighborhood Board No. 29, and several concerned individuals testified in support of this bill. The Kaneohe Bay Regional Council and numerous concerned individuals opposed this measure.


