Your Committee on Tourism & Culture, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2813, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE OF HAWAII ENDOWMENT
FUND, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to support orchestral music in
Hawaii by appropriating an unspecified amount of funds into the
State of Hawaii Endowment Fund for the production of music by an
Oahu-based symphony orchestra, provided that the funds are matched
dollar-for-dollar by private funds.

The Musicians' Association of Hawaii, Oahu County Committee
of the Democratic Party of Hawaii, and numerous concerned
individuals supported this bill. The Hawaii State Foundation on
Culture and the Arts supported the intent of this bill.


Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting an appropriation amount of \$10,000,000; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,
clarity, and consistency.
