Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which  
was referred S.B. No. 2882, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS  
PERTAINING TO THE CIVIL AIR PATROL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to help ensure the rescue mission  
capability of the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol by appropriating funds  
for a capital improvement project of the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol.

Specifically, this bill appropriates unspecified amounts for  
the design, construction, and repair of the roof hangar at the  
Hawaii wing headquarters of the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this bill  
from the Department of Defense, the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol, and  
two individuals.


Your Committee finds that the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol--a  
peacetime auxiliary of the Air Force--seeks to fulfill three  
missions: to provide search and rescue services and to administer  
aerospace education and the cadet programs. The Hawaii Civil Air  
Patrol also actively participates in counter-drug operations in  
cooperation with the Drug Enforcement Agency and plays a part in  
disaster relief, homeland security, and medical emergency  
transport.



Your Committee believes that the appropriation to fund the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol's maintenance and repair project made in this measure will increase the effectiveness of Civil Air Patrol's operations and will allow it to continue its mission to serve the people of Hawaii.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2882, S.D. 1, and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance.


