S.B. No. 3118, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to increase funding for research-
related equipment and facilities at the University of Hawaii (UH)
by:


- (1) Reclassifying the UH Research and Training Revolving
Fund as a special fund;
- (2) Retaining all indirect overhead funds generated by UH
research and training programs in the UH Training and
Research Special Fund (Fund) for research-related
equipment and facilities, instead of allocating portions
to the Discoveries and Inventions and Housing Assistance
Revolving Funds; and
- (3) Authorizing expenditures from the Fund for repair and
replacement of research-related equipment and
facilities.

UH supported the intent of this measure.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 3118, S.D. 2, and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
