Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 41 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE ON AGING TO
COLLABORATE ON PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION TO SENIORS AND TO
VISUALLY IMPAIRED PERSONS, AND EXPRESSING THE LEGISLATURE'S
SUPPORT FOR FEDERAL LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR
ITNAMERICA FOR A FIVE-YEAR NATIONAL ROLL-OUT AND GRANTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to assist the
elderly and visually impaired persons of Hawaii by:

- (1) Requesting the Department of Transportation and the
Executive Office on Aging to collaborate on providing
transportation to seniors and the visually impaired; and
- (2) Expressing the Legislature's support for federal
legislation to provide funding for Independent
Transportation Network America for a five-year national
roll-out and grants.

Your Committee finds that the elderly and visually impaired
need safe and reliable access to and from their activities of
daily living and that this concurrent resolution requests and
expresses legislative support for a means to accomplish this goal.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 41 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
