Your Committees on Transportation and Labor & Public
Employment, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 95 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
HONOLULU TO IMPROVE THE SYNCHRONIZATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS ON
ALA MOANA BOULEVARD BETWEEN PUNCHBOWL STREET AND KALAKAUA
AVENUE, AND TO ASSUME JURISDICTION OF THAT SAME PORTION OF
ROAD IN THE INTEREST OF PROMOTING SAFE TRAFFIC FLOW,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to urge the City
and County of Honolulu to improve the synchronization of traffic
signals on Ala Moana Boulevard between Punchbowl Street and
Kalakaua Avenue, and to assume jurisdiction of that same portion
of road in the interest of promoting safe traffic flow.

The Department of Transportation testified in support of this
measure.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Transportation and Labor & Public Employment that
are attached to this report, your Committees concur with the
intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 95 and recommend its adoption.
