Your Committee on Water, Land, & Ocean Resources, to which  
was referred S.C.R. No. 98, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF  
HONOLULU TO PROCEED WITH CAUTION IN REVIEWING DEVELOPMENTS ON  
STEEP HILLSIDES WITH POTENTIAL ROCKFALL HAZARDS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to protect the  
public's health and safety by urging the City and County of  
Honolulu to proceed with caution in reviewing developments on  
steep hillsides with potential rockfall hazards.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources testified in  
support of this measure. The Department of Planning and  
Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu and the Land Use  
Research Foundation of Hawaii offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this concurrent resolution by  
adding language requesting the Legislative Reference Bureau to  
contact the National Conference of State Legislatures and other  
states and county jurisdictions for statutes, ordinances, and  
rules relating to permitting development in areas subject to  
rockslides, and report back to the Legislature 15 days before the  
Regular Session of 2007.
