to which was referred H.B. No. 1863 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to implement the recommendations
of the Interagency Working Group regarding the transfer of
functions specified by Act 51, Session of Laws of Hawaii 2004, the
Reinventing Education Act of 2004, by:

- (1) Repealing the transfer of certain functions from the
Department of Budget and Finance, Department of the
Attorney General, and Department of Human Services to
the Department of Education (DOE); and
- (2) Delaying the transfer of school health aides and public
health nurses from the Department of Health to the DOE.

The Department of the Attorney General, DOE, Department of
Human Services, Department of Human Resources Development,
Department of Health, Department of Budget and Finance, and the
Interagency Working Group testified in support of this measure.
The Hawaii Government Employees Association testified in support
of the intent of this measure.
