Sir:

Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 3194, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE COMMISSION FOR NATIONAL
AND COMMUNITY SERVICE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to reduce the term of
appointment for members of the Commission for National and
Community Service from four years to three years.

Your Committee finds that the National and Community Service
Act allows three-year terms on the State Commission for National
and Community Service, whereas current state law establishes
four-year terms. The Commission must be in compliance with
federal law to be eligible for grants or allotments, or to receive
a distribution of approved national service positions. Your
Committee finds that this measure will make state law consistent
with federal law.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 3194, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, and recommends that it pass Third
Reading.
