Your Committee on Education and Military Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 47 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO SUPPORT IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF THE NATION'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS BY SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASING EDUCATION FUNDING,"

The purpose of this measure is to request that the President and the United States Congress support public schools by increasing funding to implement the No Child Left Behind Act, the Higher Education Act, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, and other education-related programs.
